

Our Objective:

Establishment of a Multi Bio-Feedstocks Plantation in the Country of Guyana to supply Seed Oil Seeds for the production of Biofuels (Jet A-1 Fuel) and Bio-byproducts.

BUSINESS INCENTIVES



Summary of Investment Incentives Available to Global Leaf Energy as a Domestic and Foreign Investor

- Exemption from Customs Duty on all plant machinery and equipment
- Exemption from Customs Duty on raw materials and packaging materials used in the production of goods by manufacturers
- Exemption from Customs Duty and zero rate of Value-Added-Tax on raw materials and packaging for manufacturers who export 50 percent or more of their products
- Unlimited carryover of losses from previous years
- Accelerated depreciation on plant and machinery for approval activities
- Full and unrestricted repatriation of capital, profits and dividends
- Benefits of double taxation treaties with the UK, Canada, Kuwait and Caricom countries
- Exemption from Customs Duty and zero rate of Value-Added-Tax on items approved under an Investment Agreement between the Government and the Business
- Exemption from Excise Tax on items approved under an Investment Agreement between the Government and the Business
- Zero rate of Value-Added-Tax on exports
- Other incentives with the Government are still in negotiations.

BUYER COMMITMENT



Global Leaf Energy Has Secured The Commitment of a Buyer That Has Issued a Letter of Intent (LOI) for a Long Term Offtake Agreement

- **GLE** has secured the commitment of a buyer. With the commitment to excellence and extensive global experience, the Buyer is a fully integrated oil and gas group that has accumulated a decade of operations, investments and partnerships in the oil and gas sectors, as well as in commodities.
- The Buyer is in the advanced progress stage of building the first of two (2) biofuel refineries to produce several biofuel products (Jet A-1 Fuel) and biomass. The first refinery is scheduled to begin production in the last quarter of 2017 and it will have a feedstock crushing capacity of 2.5 MTY. The buyer has issued to Global Leaf Energy a Letter of Intent (LOI) for a long term Offtake Agreement to supply the full amount of feedstock (2.5 MTY) for the first refinery. The Offtake Agreement will be for 10 years with renewable options of 5 years. The bio-feedstock requested by the buyer is for Jatropha Seeds and Canola Seeds aka Rapeseed. Also, GLE will produce Castro Seed Oil Seeds, Peanuts and other Feedstocks.
